बिन्दु संख्या-1 :- विकलांगों के सहायतार्थ एवं चिकित्सा सुविधाओं के विस्तार हेतु उ0प्र0 राज्य लाटरी योजना वर्ष 1969 में प्रारम्भ की गयी थी, जिसके लिये उ0प्र0 राज्य लाटरी नियमावली 1969 प्रख्यापित की गयी थी। लाटरी का प्रथम ड्रा दिनांक 16.3.1969 को सम्पन्न हुआ। राज्य लाटरियों के संचालन हेतु उ0प्र0 राज्य लाटरी निदेशालय का गठन किया गया जिसका ढांचा निम्नवत है-

बिन्दु संख्या-2 :- विभाग के कार्मिकों द्वारा प्रदेश के लाटरी योजनाओं का संचालन, योजनाओं से सम्बन्धित अभिलेखों का अनुरक्षण किया जाना था।

बिन्दु संख्या-3 :- विभाग के संचालन हेतु समस्त प्रशासनिक एवं वित्तीय अधिकार निदेशक, उ०प्र० राज्य लाटरी में निहित है। निदेशक लाटरी के सहयोग हेतु निदेशालय में 3 राजपत्रित अधिकारी एवं 102 अराजपत्रित अधिकारी नियुक्त किये गये थे। निदेशक द्वारा यथा आवश्यकता कार्य वितरण/प्रतिनिधायन के अनुसार विभिन्न स्तरों पर कार्यवाही पर्यवेक्षण किया जाता था।

लाटरी योजनायें जुलाई 1995 से बन्द हो जाने के कारण वर्तमान में निम्नलिखित प्रतिनिधायन अधीनस्थ अधिकारियों/कर्मचारियों को किये गये है :-

बिन्दु संख्या-5 :- लाटरी योजनाओं के संचालन हेतु उ०प्र० राज्य लाटरी रूल्स 1969 प्रख्यापित किया गया था जो निम्नवत है —

UTTAR PADESH STATE LOTTERY RULES, 1969

In supersession of the U.P. State Lottery Rules, 1968 (except rule 25 thereof which shall stand superseded after the close of the second draw of the State Lottery already announced) published with notification no. L-2/1966, dated December 5, 1968, notified in U.P. Government Gazette Extraordinary, dated December 5, 1968, the State Government hereby makes the following Rules for the conduct of State Lotteries:

1. (1) These Rules may be called the Uttar Pradesh State Lottery Rules, 1969.

(2) These Rules (except Rule 25) shall come into force with effect from the date of their publication in the official Gazette, and Rule-25 shall come into force with effect from the date of announcement of sale of tickets for the third draw of the State Lottery.

2. (1) The Uttar Pradesh State Lottery Scheme (hereinafter referred to as the State Lottery), shall be conducted by the Government of Uttar Pradesh (hereinafter referred to as the Government).

(2) The funds raised as a result of the implementation of the State Lottery shall be utilised for such purposes and in such manner as may be notified by the Government from time to time.

3. The Director of State Lottery, Uttar Pradesh with headquarters at Lucknow (hereinafter referred to as the Director), shall administer the State Lottery under the overall control of the Secretary to Government of Uttar Pradesh, Finance Department, Lucknow.

4. The tickets for the State Lottery bearing facsimile signatures of Secretary to Government of Uttar Pradesh, Finance Department shall be printed at the Government Press by the Superintendent, Printing and Stationary, Uttar Pradesh.

5. The tickets shall be printed with a counterfoil and shall be issued in distinct and separate series and each series shall bear a distinct alphabetical notation. The Government shall decide the number of series to be released for sale for each draw and the number of tickets in each such series. The tickets in each series shall be numbered consecutively and issued in books of such number of consecutively numbered tickets as the Government may from time to time, decide.

6. The tickets for state Lottery shall be issued in such denomination as the State Government may prior to the announcement of sale of tickets for any draw notify in this behalf and until any other denomination is so notified the tickets shall be issued in the denomination of Re 1 only.

7. The number and value of the prizes for any draw shall be such as may be notified by the Government in this behalf and to which wide publicity shall be given.

8. A person may purchase any number of tickets but no ticket shall be sold to a person below the age of 16 years. However, tickets may be purchased on behalf of a person below the age of 16 years by his guardian or parent.

9. No ticket shall be eligible for more than one prize in a draw. In the event of more than one prize being drawn by a particular ticket, the ticket holder shall be entitled to the highest of the prizes on that ticket.

10. The Government stands guarantee for the payment of the prize money.

11. The Lottery tickets shall normally be made available for sale through authorised agents to be appointed for this purpose. The Director may, however, make arrangements for the sale of tickets to individuals or the public in any other manner considered necessary.

12. The District Magistrates within their districts and the Director in respect of States and areas outside Uttar Pradesh having reciprocal arrangements with Uttar Pradesh shall have power to appoint any person or institution as an agent who applies for such an agency in form UPL-I. The decision of the District Magistrate or the Director, as the case may be, shall be final and no appeal against the order of appointment or rejection of application shall be entertained. The appointment letters shall be issued to the agents by the District Magistrates or the Director, as the case may be, in Form UPL-2 with copy to the Treasury or Sub-Treasury to which the agent is assigned. The term of appointment of an agent shall expire after each draw unless extended or renewed by the District Magistrate or the Director, as the case may be. No Government servant shall be eligible for appointment as an agent.

13. Every District Magistrate and the Director shall maintain a register showing the names of agents appointed by him, their addresses, agency numbers and treasury or sub-treasury to which they have been assigned.

14. The Lottery tickets shall be issued to the agents on payment of full cost less commission after rubber-stamping the name of the Treasury, Sub-Treasury or the Directorate from which they are issued. The Treasury, Sub Treasury or the Directorate as the case may be, shall also issue a signed voucher in Form UPL-3 giving the particulars of the tickets books and sold to each agent, his name and agency number on each occasion and obtain a receipt.

15. The agents in Uttar Pradesh shall be required to produce the letter of appointment at the treasury or sub-treasury each time for verification before the tickets are issued to them.

16. Lottery tickets (in books), to agents outside Uttar Pradesh shall be issued together with a voucher in Form UPL-3 by the Director, after receiving payment in cash less commission by means of a money order, postal order or bank draft. The Director shall ensure that reciprocal

arrangements with the State or area where the agent will operate exist. No claim for loss of ticket books in transit shall be entertained.

17. Ticket books shall be sold to agents only in the form of complete books. Tickets books once sold shall not be returnable.

18. (1) The Government shall allow to the agents, commission at rates fixed and notified by Government in advance for each draw. The rates shall not be altered in respect of any draw after the announcement of the sale of tickets for that draw. The Government may decide from time to time, the manner in which the commission, prizes etc. shall be paid or adjusted.

(2) Out of every prize of Rs.1,000 and above payable to a winner in respect of any ticket, an amount equivalent to 5 percent of the prize money shall be deducted and paid as bonus to the agent who had sold such ticket.

19. An agent entitled to bonus, can obtain it by making an application in Form UPL-4 within 30 days from the date on which results of the draw are notified in the official Gazette. He shall enclose the relevant voucher issued to him by the treasury, sub treasury or the Director at the time of the sale of tickets and the counter-foil as proof that the ticket book containing the prize winning ticket was actually issued to him.

20. The District Magistrate or the Director, as the case may be, shall have the power to terminate the appointment made by him of any agent and also to forfeit his security deposit, if any, in case any irregularities are noticed by him in the discharge of his functions as an agent.

21. The tickets (in complete books) remaining unsold with the treasuries or sub treasuries shall be destroyed in the presence of a Magistrate or such other officer as may be deputed by the District

Magistrate as soon as possible after the sale are closed. The District Magistrate shall furnish the details of such tickets (in complete books) and a certificate of destruction to the Director before such date prior to the draw as may be fixed in this behalf and shall preserve one copy thereof for record. The ticket books remaining unsold with the Director shall also be destroyed under his directions.

22. In respect of each draw the Director shall notify the following dates namely:

- (a) date on which sale of the tickets shall commence;
- (b) date of closing of sales by treasuries and sub-treasuries; and
- (c) the date of the draw.

23. Publicity shall be given about the time and place where the draw is to be held and the lottery tickets shall also bear, inter alia, the date of the draw and the number and value of prizes.

24. The draw shall be held in the presence of seven persons to be appointed by Government as judges, including a Chairman to supervise the draw. the presence of any three judges shall constitute the quorum.

25. (1) The draw shall be carried out by means of rotating drums or by a Draw machine according to the procedure described in sub-paras (3) and (4) below, unless the State Government orders by notification prior to the commencement of sale of tickets for a draw that it shall be by any other device mechanical, electrical or manual.

(2) Before the commencement of the Draw, the Director shall submit to the judges a list indicating the notations of the different series of tickets sold and a list of number of tickets issued in each series together with a list of tickets remaining unsold and reported by District

Magistrates as having been destroyed. A list of tickets remaining unsold with the Director and destroyed shall also be submitted.

(3) Procedure with drums -There shall be seven drums located in a conspicuous place where the draw is conducted. The drums shall bear the following lables:

The first drum shall contain as many discs as the number of notations for various series each disc bearing one notation. The remaining six drums (numbers II to VII), shall contain 10 discs each bearing digit 0 and 1 to 9 provided that if the tickets issued under rule 5 do not extend to all the 10 digits in respect of any drum the discs to be contained in such drum shall be limited to those as cover the digits for which tickets have been issued. The draw shall commence with the drawal of the First Prize winning number. The judges shall satisfy themselves that all the aforesaid discs are put in the drums before the draw begins and also before any notation or number is taken out. The drums shall then be rotated by persons duly approved by the Judges, and after some time, allowed to come to rest on the direction of the Judges. Each drum shall then be opened in the ascending order of the numbers given to the drums and one disc from each taken out by the person or persons approved by the Judges. The Judges shall read out the number so constructed by assembling the notation of the series and the digits obtained from the drums numbers I to VII in the same sequence. The same operation shall be repeated for drawing all the remaining prizes of each category. The prize winning numbers shall be constructed one by one and the number shall be read out by the Chairman and thereafter it shall be announced. The Judges may if they consider it necessary so to do with a view to expedite the result of the draw use additional sets of seven drums each for drawing prizes of the value of Rs. 500 or below and in such event the procedure followed for drawing the numbers shall be the same as applicable to the first set of drums.

(4) Procedure with Draw Machine - In the alternative, if the Judges desire in the interests of a quicker draw they may use a Draw Machine, having seven circular discs which can be rotated together by means of a cycle chain arrangement. The discs shall bear the following tables:

The discs will be divided into radial sectors. The sectors on the first disc will be marked with the alphabetical notations denoting the various series. There will be ten sectors on the other discs and they will be marked to denote digits 0 and from 1 to 9 in sequence. There will be fixed pointers beside every disc to indicate the sector from which the notation or the digit has to be read.

To draw a winning number the discs will be rotated on the directions of the judges and then left to come to a stop by themselves. When the discs have stopped the series notation and the digits indicated by the pointers on the discs read in the sequence of ascending order of the number given to the discs shall form the winning number.

(5) If the number drawn out for any of the first four categories of prizes happens to be of an unsold ticket (i.e. ticket not issued to agents or tickets not otherwise sold under Rule 11), the process shall be repeated till the number of a sold ticket is drawn, but in the case of other categories of prizes the prize on the number of an unsold ticket if taken out shall be retained by the Government.

26. As soon as a particular prize winning number has been drawn and announced it shall be recorded in Register to be kept in the personal custody of the Director. The Judge - Chairman shall also enter in his own hand the number in a register to be maintained by him. On completion of the draw the judges present will be required to sign both these registers.

27. The prize money shall be paid by the Director on the prize winner surrendering the prize winning ticket and furnishing a stamped receipt in token of having received the prize.

28. The outstation prize-winners may send to the Director the prize winning ticket and the stamped receipt by registered post including whether they would like their prize money to be remitted to them by bank draft, postal order or money order, the charges for which will be borne by the prize winner. No claim for the loss of the ticket etc., in transit shall be entertained.

29. The prize-winners shall claim the prize money with 30 days from the date of publication of the result in the official Gazette. Prize money or bonus money not claimed within this period shall lapse and be automatically forfeited to Government.

Provided that the Government may on application made in this behalf within 30 days from the date of the publication of result in the official Gazette authorize payment of the prize money or bonus, if it is satisfied that the prize winner or agent, as the case may be, was for sufficient reasons prevented from claiming the money within 30 days from the date of publication of the result in the official Gazette.

30. The list of ticket numbers winning the prizes shall be notified in the official Gazette which shall constitute official announcement of the results and shall also be given wide publicity.

31. The accounts in respect of each draw shall be audited by the Examiner, U.P. Local Fund Audit, Allahabad and the audit report shall be submitted to Government by the Director in due course.

32. After the draw is over, the record and papers relating to the State Lottery shall be kept in the custody of the Director.

33. Governemnt may modify, add to or alter the rules in such manner as may be expedient, by notifying such changes in the official

Gazette and giving publicity for the information of the agents and the general public. However, the number and amounts of the different prizes and the procedure relating to the drawal of prize winning tickets shall not be altered in respect of any draw after the date notified for the commencement of sale of tickets.

34. If any question arises as to the interpretation of these rules, or any other matter not provided in these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Government whose decision thereon shall be final.

35. The legal jurisdiction in all matters concerning the State Lottery shall be Lucknow.
